

Instruction guide

Warning! Important safety instructions

- Do not modify, disassemble, open, drop, crush or shed the battery pack.
- The battery pack contains a lithium-polymer battery inside as power source, which is flammable. Keep away from open flame.
- If the Li-polymer battery inside the pack leaks or begins to swell or expand, emits a strong odor, or becomes hot to touch, discontinue use the battery immediately, and have the product examined by qualified electronic technician.
- The battery pack should be used in the temperature between 45-90 (degrees Fahrenheit) or 7-32(degrees Celsius).
- Do not leave the battery on prolonged charge when not in use.
- The battery pack is not toy, please keep it away from children.

Charge battery pack

- Slide the switch to "Off" position
- Using MiniUSB cable to connect the battery pack with computer or USB car charger or USB AC charger (a USB car charger is included, USB AC charger is included in iPhone's retail box from Apple).
- Red LED on backup battery will be turned on indicating that charging is in process. When Red LED turns off, charging is complete. It may take 4-8 hours depends on the charging rate to fully charge the battery pack.

Charge iPhone/iPod

- Open the cap and slide the switch to "On" position. Green LED turns on, plug the battery pack into iPhone 3G, iPhone or iPod, charging will be initiated instantly.
- When green LED turns off, all energy in battery pack has been transferred. It must be recharged before using it the next time.
