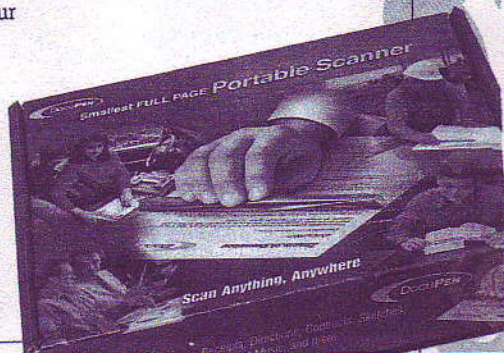
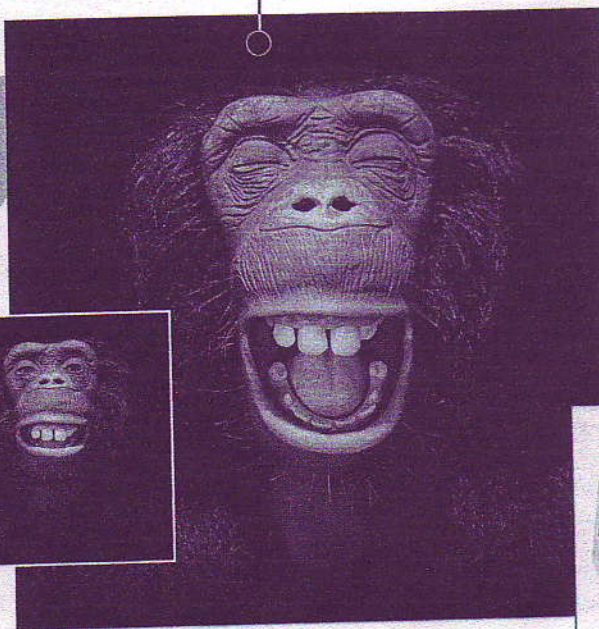
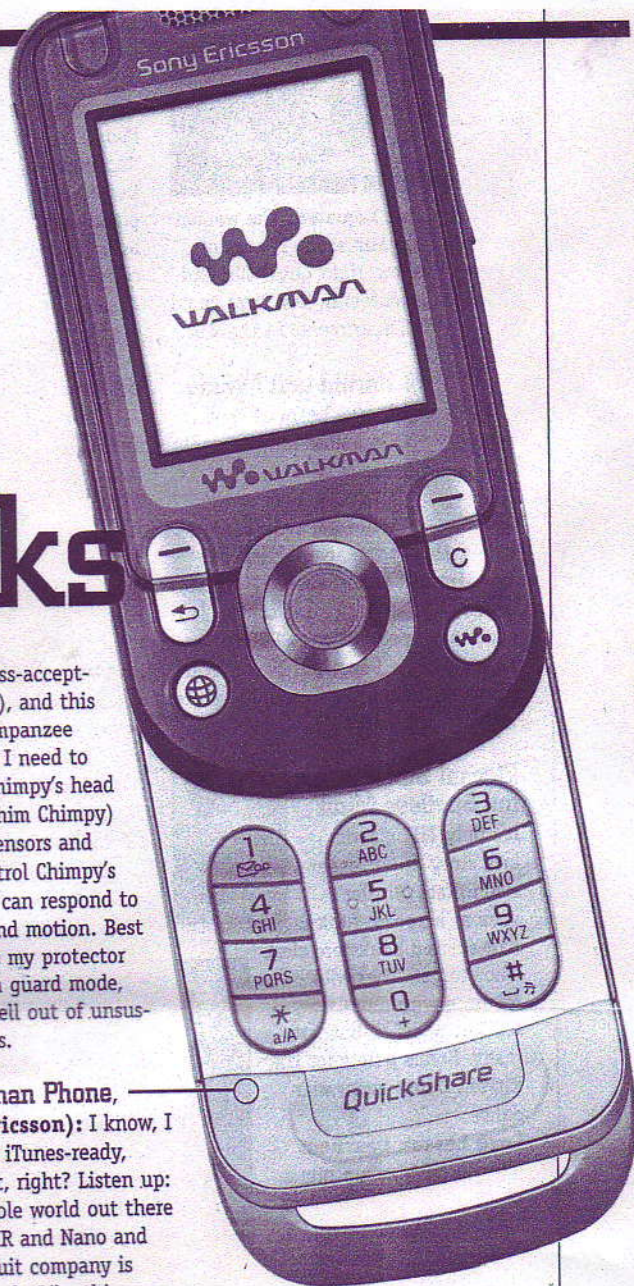
**WowWee Alive Chimpanzee**, \$150 (Sharper Image): So my monkey love is shining through
