Now You Can Charge Your Cellphone Anywhere (Even if You're Nowhere)

You're walking through East No-where and the battery in your cellphone or P.D.A. dies. There's no place to plug in a charger, and besides, you don't have time to hang around while the battery recharges. Cellphone battery boosters have been around for a while, but they have built-in batteries that need periodic recharging as well.

But with the Turbo Charge from Voxred, you can recharge your phone with a AA battery. The company claims the charger, which you plug into the phone or P.D.A. with an adapter, can give you up to two hours of talk time or 40 hours on standby. It comes with your choice of adapter and a battery (\$19.95). Additional adapters are \$2.95 each.

The lipstick-size charger is available now at www.turbocharge.com, and will be in stores later this year.

That means no more missed calls and no more excuses for not returning a call, even if you're stuck in East No-where.
